



Dr. Dale Underwood has completed his portion of the English Video Edition through our partnership with Harding University. Dr. Whit Jordan, Associate Professor there, is now completing our Spanish Edition. These tools will be valuable with the increasing number of jails and prisons now making tablets available. They will be a valuable asset to our friends at NewLife Behavior *International* (NLBI) in worldwide efforts among the Spanish-speaking population of the world. These ministries work well together in their separate ways to expand the use of this curriculum. While waiting for the final touches at Harding, Dr. Underwood is preparing a 6-8 lesson *youth* version of *A Sense of Self* to meet a specific need with minors in custody. In addition to his many other skills, Dale has been active in youth ministries and camps for 25 years. When completed, this will be a useful tool in similar facilities everywhere.

The Endowment Fund has not been in existence long but is already at the \$50,000 mark. A "special" thanks is due those donating in the **April Drive**. This


