NEWLIFE BEHAVIOR CURRICULUM IMPACT CONTINUES

NewLife Behavior Ministries normally operates within the United States. Our sister organization, NewLife Behavior International, based in Dallas, is dedicated to using NLB curriculum to help spread the gospel and minister to people outside of the United States. We support each other and collaborate when it helps each other's mission.

This trip came about through years of work. *Buck Griffith* has been working with *Mayra Melendez* for several years on getting all of the NLB courses translated into Spanish. We discovered Mayra and her translating talents while working with *Luis Melendez* (her husband) who is part of the missions staff at the **Sunset International Bible Institute** (SIBI).







Mayra's translating skills are rapidly beginning to allow NLBM to update existing courses and get newly written courses translated! Over the years, NLB courses have made their way to Central American countries. However, new courses and revised translations are making NewLife Behavior courses more understandable.

Twenty years ago, technology such as thumb-drives did not exist. Presently, these drives have the capacity to place **ALL** of our translated courses with **ALL** of the lessons in each course. To think of that much information on 100 thumb-drives fitting into a single gallon-sized Ziploc bag- wow!



Dale also was privileged to teach and preach on Sunday at a congregation in Tipitapa (about 15 miles from Managua into the interior). This congregation has planted 25 other congregations with a plan to plant a new church every two years!

Be on the lookout for the NewLife Behavior Ministries Facebook site as well as our website (nlbm.org) for interviews we conducted while still in Nicaragua on the expected impact of the NLBM Spanish curriculum! Leaders from thirty-three churches in Nicaragua met to hear about NewLife Behavior courses. At the end of the day, one hundred flash drives were given that contain NLB Spanish courses.
